APPLICATION FOR PANEL MEMBERSHIP

The New York City Bar Legal Referral Service (the “Service” or “LRS”) was created by The New York City Bar Association and the New York County Lawyers’ Association (the “Associations”) under the auspices of the Associations’ Joint Committee on Legal Referral Service (the “Joint Committee”). The Service is now operated solely by the New York City Bar Association. The LRS is a public service and exists primarily for the benefit of the public.

Application Process Overview

The LRS approval process is a serious one. LRS does not automatically accept every applicant even if they have been practicing law for many years. This allows the LRS to recommend lawyers to the public with confidence. It also makes it more likely that the participating lawyers or “Panel Members” we recommend will be retained.

Your application will be used to evaluate your suitability for panel membership and, if you are interviewed, will inform the scope of your **interview**. Interviews help further evaluate your experience and allow you to meet with some of the LRS staff and Panel Members who practice in the same or similar areas of law as you.

Application Procedures

In applying to the LRS, you must select one of the two application paths: 1) you meet the applicable [Panel Qualification Standards](#) for each area of law for which you are applying, or; 2) you do not meet all of the applicable Panel Qualification Standards for each area of law for which you are applying, but believe that you have sufficient equivalent experience to support LRS membership and participation in each area of law for which you are applying.

You may select **up to three** major areas, or “**panels**,” of law for which you would like to be considered. These panels are listed below as part of this application. Please do not apply for more than three panels. You will notice that each panel also includes sub-specialties or “subpanels.” For example, the panel “Family Law” includes subpanels such as “custody,” “divorce,” and “guardianship.” There is no limit on how many subpanels for which you may apply under each panel. Please do not apply for any panel for which you do not meet the stated [Panel Qualification Standards](#) and do not have sufficient requisite experience to support an application based on equivalencies.
