Congratulations on your appointment as Director of the Mayor's Office of Criminal Justice. The City Bar looks forward to working with you on the criminal justice issues that we know are so important to you.

As you know, the City Bar is an independent organization and professional home for over 24,000 lawyers and law students dedicated to addressing legal and public policy issues in ways that promote law reform, ethics and the fair and effective administration of justice. In May 2013, the City Bar issued the enclosed report, *Policy Recommendations for New York City's Next Mayor*.¹ A collaborative effort of 27 committees, the report discusses and makes recommendations regarding access to justice and a number of important policy matters facing New York City today, from the perspectives of lawyers who work daily on issues vital to the City's welfare. As you'll see from Section III of the report, we address a number of criminal justice issues that we hope will be considered – to the extent they are not already being considered - by the new administration.
